

TransDigm: House Oversight Committee Staff Investigating Company Practices Detailed in OIG Report

Staffers on the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform are conducting their own investigation into TransDigm's business practices, according to sources familiar with the matter.

The congressional interest, according to sources, was sparked by the Department of Defense Office of Inspector General's recent [audit](#) of TransDigm, which found that the company earned excessive profits on 99% of government contracts that the OIG reviewed.

The OIG's audit was initiated in response to [letters](#) from members of Congress, including Representative Ro Khanna of California, who is a member of the House Oversight Committee. Representative Jackie Speier of California, another member of the committee, has also previously expressed concern regarding TransDigm's business practices.

It is not known what additional steps the committee may take.
